**Form:** *Sedge or Flax*      **Height:** 0.5 – 1.5 m      **Spread:** 0.6 – 2 m      **Flowers:** Brown      **Type:** Globular      **Flowering time:** All year round

**Ecological functions:**



**Soils:** gravel, sand or loam; acidic, alkaline or neutral

**Germination rate:** 3 to 6 weeks

**Seed collecting:** collect seed-heads that are brown and come off easily with your fingers.

**Seed treatment:** none

**Sowing requirements:** sow on top of damp soil and cover with a layer of gravel. Sow in Late Spring to Summer.

**Position:** full sun, part shade.

**Supplementary watering:** none

**Uses:** planted singly or in groups for mixed landscapes as a feature or mass planted, in borders, verges, median strips and roundabouts. Extremely hardy and variable, can be used as a sand-binder.

**Notes:** Tends to grow in clumps, do not thin out.
