## Woolly New Holland Daisy



(Seeds of South Australia)

**Form:** *Low shrub*

**Height:** *0.5 – 1 m*

**Spread:** *0.5 – 1 m*

**Flowers:** *Blue*

**Type:** *Daisy*

**Flowering time:** *Spring, Summer*

**Ecological functions:**



**Soils:** *clay or loam; alkaline or neutral*

**Germination rate:** *1 to 3 weeks*

**Seed collecting:** collect seedheads from plants.

**Seed treatment:** none

**Sowing requirements:** sprinkle seeds on top of damp soil and cover with a layer of gravel. Sow in Autumn. Requires well-drained soils.

**Position:** full sun

**Supplementary watering:** minimal

**Uses:** hardy, perennial self-seeding herb for borders, verges and roundabouts. Mass planted as an understorey or in drifts in native landscapes.

**Notes:** short lived.
