Form: *Sedge or Flax*

Height: *0.5 – 1.5 m*

Spread: *0.6 – 2 m*

Flowers: *Brown*

Type: *Globular* **Flowering time:** *All year round*

Ecological functions:



Soils: *gravel, sand or loam; acidic, alkaline or neutral*

Germination rate: *3 to 6 weeks*

Seed collecting: collect seed-heads that are brown and come off easily with your fingers.

Seed treatment: none

Sowing requirements: sow on top of damp soil and cover with a layer of gravel. Sow in Late Spring to Summer.

Position: full sun, part shade.

Supplementary watering: none

Uses: planted singly or in groups for mixed landscapes as a feature or mass planted, in borders, verges, median strips and roundabouts. Extremely hardy and variable, can be used as a sand-binder.

Notes: tends to grow in clumps, do not thin out.
